

WHAT IS 15+?

A 1-YEAR PROGRAM: for students who are at least 15 years of age as of September 30.

(pre-vocational training program): 1-year academic project to prepare students to enter a vocational training program

- General education component Sec 3: English, French, Math, Entrepreneuship and Exploration of Vocational Training
- Choice of one of the following: Woodworking, Small Motors Mechanic or Skills for Living

What is 2 4 U?

(Concomitance program): 2-year academic project to prepare students to obtain their Diploma of Vocational Studies and their Secondary School Diploma

- General education component (English, French, Math and Exploration of Vocational Training) at the LVTC
- Practical training component (Vocational Training Degree)
