

AGRHS Distance Learning 2021 - 2022

- All classes follow the AGRHS Cycle Calendar and usual timetable (<u>MAPs & Regular</u>; <u>15+ & WOTP</u>).
 - Students are expected to be present online during the assigned time in the schedule. Attendance will be taken and recorded in report cards.
 - The class teacher communicates to their students the means of accessing classes.
 - Exceptional situations where the student is unable to participate in the live virtual class, the parent is expected to call in the absence to the House Office or email as per usual school protocol.
 - Absences from Distance Learning classes that have not been justified by the parent will be treated as unauthorized/unjustified absences as per usual school protocol.
 - Classes will follow the MEQ Guidelines of Distance Learning (For each 75 minute class: approximately 40 minutes teaching; 20 minutes working autonomously; 15 minutes teacher availability)
 - Expect overlap of the sections of instruction (ie. use of breakout rooms in distance education to facilitate individual or small group instruction and assessment).
 - Google Classroom remains the source of all asynchronous learning materials.
 - Questions or issues accessing online lessons should be brought to the attention of the teacher as soon as possible.
