GOOD NEWS! There are still spots available in the Performing Arts Concentration program for the 2022-23 school year! This program is for students who are passionate about and dedicated to the performing arts, namely, theatre, dance, and music. With 7 blocks of concentration in Cycle 1 and 6 blocks in Cycle 2, per the 9-day schedule, students in the program will have lots of class time to learn theory, history, and develop their skills in each field. The Cycle 1 program explores a broad introduction to a variety of topics in theatre, dance, and music over a 2-year curriculum to limit repetition. In Cycle 2, students will have more of an opportunity to fine-tune their skills in the area that interests them the most. In general, students can expect 3 major performances in front of a live audience, workshops with experts in all three fields, opportunities to see professional-level shows, field trips, and more depending on Covid-19 restrictions.
