June Programming: With June 10th as the last day of regular classes for all but WOTP, we are moving into the final Ministry exam period for students in Sec. 4 & 5 as well as targeted instruction & reassessment for those who have pre-registered from Sec. 1-3 (including MAPs). Please be reminded that students are not permitted to roam during the June 13-23 period. When not in exams or classes, they must be in prep sessions, an organized activity, or a designated study location. Students in Sec. 4 & 5 are permitted to leave after their exam if they do not have other mandatory activities in the schedule - however, it is important to understand that students who leave during the day prior to dismissal are not permitted to take the school bus at the end of the day.

<u>Exams</u>: Authorized absences are restricted to Covid (Dr's note not required, a written note by the parent is adequate) or other illness (with Dr's note), death in the family, or court appearance. For quick reference: <u>AGRHS June Exam Schedule</u>.

<u>Chromebook Collection</u>: All students who are not returning to AGRHS must return their Chromebook on their last day at AGRHS at the latest. Collections have taken place in class and there will be additional collections at each of the level 5 exams. Students who missed their in-class collection or wish to return the Chromebook before their final exam may do so at Central Office. The Chromebook, charger and power cord must all be returned. Damage deemed intentional or by misuse will result in charges to the student account. Failure to return the device results in a police report for theft. Students who are returning to Galt in August may keep their device over the summer.

Cafeteria Service: Cafeteria service remains available through June 23rd.

<u>Yearbook Pre-Sale</u>: A limited number of yearbooks remain available for purchase at \$50. If interested, please contact Ms. Montgomery in Student Activities. First come first served:)

<u>Consumable Fees</u>: Another reminder that full payment of school fees is now past due. We will be moving forward with a collection agency at the end of June. Therefore I encourage you to verify the status of your child's account and to please complete all outstanding payments. A reminder that individual student fundraising accounts may be utilized for school fees.

<u>Summer School/Supplemental Exams</u>: Once again summer school for Ministry Courses with uniform exams will be provided online through LEARN. There is a July 7th registration deadline. For more information and the registration link please visit: <u>LEARN Summer School</u> Once again, ETSB will cover \$100 of the costs of each course provided the student fully attends and participates (\$150 paid by student/family & \$100 paid by ETSB).

Supplemental exams will take place between July 19 and August 2nd inclusive. Please verify the <u>ETSB website</u> for detailed information and registration for the exam(s). In order to qualify to write these exams, the student must have previously completed the course.

<u>Report Cards</u>: Report cards will be available on the parent portal by July 11th. For those unsure whether summer school is required, it is recommended to register. Where students pass the course and summer school is no longer needed, provided cancellation occurs prior to the end of the second day of classes, LEARN will reimburse.

<u>Summer Communication</u>: The primary means of communication from the school will be via the school website. Please check regularly for any important updates. All address changes need to be communicated as soon as possible via the House Office secretaries. Please note that address changes not communicated by July may result in delays in access to transportation.
