Targeted Instruction Period Sec. 1 - 3:

Targeted Instruction began Monday June 12th for all students who have registered. All information has been emailed out to the respective parent/guardian(s). Secondary 4 & 5 Exam Schedule: Please find the link to the Secondary 4 & 5 Final Exam Schedule. Please remember that students must either be in exams or in a prep session if at school - students are not permitted to roam freely during the exam schedule.

LEARN Summer School & Supplementary Uniform Exams: Please be reminded that summer school courses will again be provided through LEARN. Please find the <u>LEARN summer school flyer</u> that outlines the courses offered, schedule, registration requirements, as well as the registration link.

Note that ETSB will cover \$100 of the fees per student for courses leading to MEQ examinations.

The **deadline to register is July 6**th, but students can drop the class with full reimbursement until July 12th.

As indicated on the flyer, registration for Ministry Uniform exams is done separately with the school board. Exam registration information will be provided as soon as it becomes available.

Students in the youth sector can now access their marks and diplomas online by creating an account with the Ministry of Education. It is important that secondary 4 and 5 students create their account as soon as possible so as to have access to their ministry exam results as of July 5th, 2023. Collections will also take place prior to each Secondary 5 exam. Students returning to AGRHS keep their Chromebook for the summer unless advised otherwise due to exceptional circumstances.

Upcoming Changes to Road Signage, Speed Limits, and Campus Circulation:

Please be reminded that in the interest of safety for all entering and exiting our campus, the Ministry of Transport has been making changes to the signage and regulations applicable to the highway in front of the school. Notably, the speed limit will be 50km/hr in front of the campus, but 90km/hr on either side of the reduced speed zone. Entering the campus from the upper gate is now prohibited. Please be vigilant of the new signage in order to avoid a ticket. A number of these changes have already been put into place and we expect the remainder to be in place shortly. Please be aware that the reduced speed limit is only applicable between the hours of 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. throughout the school year - thus, if entering or exiting the campus outside of these times, please be aware that the speed of traffic will be significantly higher, thus consider this in your judgements. Also, please be advised that there will be changes to traffic circulation on campus for the upcoming school year. Details will be provided once confirmed.

<u>2023 - 2024 Timetables</u>: Returning students may anticipate their timetables for the new school year to be available on the portal by the end of the day on August 23rd.
