<u>Reminder - Scholarships & Awards 2023 - 2024</u>: Graduating students are encouraged to apply for available scholarships prior to the end of the day on **April 26**, **2024**. Please read the <u>AGRHS Scholarships & Awards Booklet</u> prior to applying and please remember to upload a copy of your acceptance letter with your <u>digital application</u>.

<u>Final Exam Schedule:</u> Please find the official <u>Final Exam Schedule</u> for Secondary 3, 4, and 5. Please note that ministry exams begin at the end of May. Regular attendance is imperative prior to and during the assessment period. Please note that secondary 3 students will be returning during the exam period to write their history, science, and math exams. Should you have any questions specific to a particular exam, please contact your child's teacher.

Solar Eclipse: Thank you to everyone who completed the survey to confirm whether your child will attend school on April 8th. As previously indicated, school remains open on April 8th. We will have regular classes through Block 3 and Block 4 will be organized as an activity block where students may choose to go outside with protective glasses (provided during block 3) or may choose from among several alternative spaces indoors where live-streaming of the eclipse will be provided or other quiet activities. As of 3:45 p.m. students will be ushered indoors where they will be organized by bus number to engage in quiet work and await dismissal. Safety presentations were provided by trained ambassadors from Bishop's University earlier this winter. As previously mentioned, for safety reasons, the campus will be closed to traffic after the morning drop-off and there will be a security guard at the entrance. Therefore, all students who come to school that day will be required to take the bus home - and as mentioned earlier, the day has been extended to 4:30 p.m. While we hope to have all buses leave at 4:30 p.m., please anticipate delays as we have been advised to plan for traffic disruptions. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

In preparation for this upcoming event, please refer to the following safety and informational video <u>How to Safely View an Eclipse</u>. All students participating in the viewing outdoors are expected to conduct themselves in accordance with safety practices.
