- Don't click on the link in the promotional emails you get; rather go to the merchant's website and shop from there.
- When it sounds too good to be true, when you're being pressed to act NOW, verify with an adult FIRST. It's usually a scam.
- Use Paypal: the app encrypts all transactions.
- When paying online, check the URL address. It must include the "S" in «https» with a little padlock...
