Plastic in our oceans!

Every single day, 13000 to 15000 pieces of plastic make their way into our oceans. Each year about 100 ,000 marine animals are killed because of plastic pollution. Marine animals who rely on their eyesight eat the plastic assuming it is food. Animals like whales, sharks, fishes, turtles often get caught in plastic or nets, which leads to injuries, pain, starvation and eventually death.
