2025 Graduation & Prom Tickets

Graduation Ticket Sales have opened and are available any recess in O-201 with Danica Mongomery. Tickets can be paid CASH or using school fundraising. Tickets are \$25 each. If you plan to use school fundraising, it is important you speak with Danica, montgomeryd@edu.etsb.qc.ca, IN_ADVANCE to the sale to make the necessary arrangements.

Sales Period 1 (Monday, April 28 to Friday, May 9): Each student will be guaranteed the opportunity to buy a maximum of 3 Graduation Ceremony Tickets. These tickets will be reserved for purchasing during this sales period.





Sales Period 2 (Monday, May 12 to Friday, May 16): All tickets left unpurchased arput back on sale on a first come, first serve basis. Students will only be able to purchase 1 additional ticket during this period.

Sales Period 3 (Tuesday, May 20 to Friday, May 23): All remaining tickets are put back on sale on a first come, first serve basis. Students will only be able to purchase a maximum of 2 additional tickets during this period.

Sales Period 4 (Monday, May 26 to Grad Ceremony): OPEN SALE. If any tickets remain unsold, they will be sold on a first come, first serve basis to Graduates and Staff (no maximums).

IMPORTANT: Graduates do not need to purchase a Graduation Ceremony Ticket for themselves. This is only for guests.

Prom Ticket Sales are also <u>OPEN NOW.</u> If Graduates plan on attending the Prom Dance, they will have to purchase their tickets **by Friday, June 6**. Tickets are 25\$ each, CASH ONLY.

Grad Trip LaRonde: This year's Graduate Trip will be to Six Flags, LaRonde, in Montreal. The trip is open to all graduating students and will take place on the **PED Day on Friday, June 6th**. ▲ Upcoming Sports Concentration Credits – Government-Issued Grants:
