WEEKLY TIP by your Community Officer



How can I get a pardon for a criminal record? Can I get it for any crime? Does it cost anything?

You must wait 5-10 years after completing your sentence before asking for a suspension of your criminal record. The waiting period depends on how serious the crime was and the date on which you were found guilty. Also, it can take six months to two years to get an answer from the Parole Board. And yes there is an application fee. **Important!** A criminal record suspension doesn't guarantee you can travel to other countries.
