



Administrative Announcement: It is with mixed emotions that I announce to our community that Mr. Kohl Kelso, current Vice-Principal of Cycle 2, has been promoted and will become the Principal of Heroes Memorial Elementary School in Cowansville, effective July 1st. Mr. Kelso has been a strong leader during his time at Alexander Galt and will be highly missed. I am pleased to welcome back to AGRHS, Ms. Adriana Lyons, who has been appointed Vice-Principal, replacing Mr. Kelso in Cycle 2. Ms. Lyons was a teacher with us for many years prior to stepping in to replace as Vice-Principal over the 2019-2020 school year, and then moving on to Principal and Vice-Principal positions at Waterloo Elementary and Richmond Regional High School. On behalf of our AGRHS community, I wish to thank Mr. Kelso for all of his contributions during his time with us, and extend a warm welcome to Ms. Lyons.

Final Reports & MEQ Results: Report cards will be available on the portal by the end of the day on June 30th, 2025. Cycle 2 students are reminded to verify their Ministry results as these are the official grades. Ministry results are expected to be available no later than July 7, 2025.

The Ministry of Education has an online portal where Secondary 4 and 5 students can consult their academic record and request an exam mark revision, if applicable.

It will be important for students to **create their account before July 4, 2025** as marks are released soon thereafter. To create an account, please click <u>here</u>. Students will need their permanent code and student ID number.

Return of Chromebooks & School Issued Items: For all Secondary 5 & non-returning students, chromebooks, chargers, and school issued items (textbooks, library books, etc.) must be returned to the school before students leave for the summer. Please find the memo detailing the return of materials.

<u>Summer School</u>: Summer school and supplemental exams will again be available this summer. Please be reminded of the requirement to adhere to *promotion by subject* at Cycle 2 that was explained in previous newsletters (students **must pass** the course in order to move up to the next level, placements are no longer permitted). Students who are unsuccessful in a subject(s) during the regular school year are highly encouraged to take advantage of the summer opportunities.

Cycle 1 Summer School: This year summer school for Cycle 1 students will be provided by <u>SuccessScolaire</u>. If your child is at risk of not passing a class, we encourage you to register as soon as possible. A refund will be provided to parents whose child passes their course in June, provided you send a cancellation request prior to the day before the first class, and provide proof of having passed the course.





Cancellation without proof of having passed the course results in a \$125 administration fee. *Cycle 1 Summer School Registration Link*

<u>Cycle 2 Summer School:</u> Summer school for Cycle 2 students is once again provided by LEARN. Please note that while students may opt to follow the Bridge course offered by SuccessScolaire (Cycle 1 Registration link), it is offered more inexpensively from LEARN. <u>Cycle 2 Summer School Registration Link</u>

<u>Summer Supplemental Exam Schedule:</u> Students who are unsuccessful in their June exams have the opportunity to rewrite specific exams required for graduation during the summer supplemental period. Please find the link to the <u>Official Supplemental Exam Schedule and Registration Link.</u> Please note that the ETSB coordinates the supplemental exams centrally at the board office. For any questions related to the retake exams, please contact the ETSB directly.

<u>Outstanding Account Balances</u>: Please note that all amounts owed will be sent to a collection agency by the end of the school year. Please verify your child's account to ensure all fees have been paid. Accounts carrying a credit balance will be carried over for returning students and applied to fees incurred in the upcoming school year. Credit balances owed to departing students will be reimbursed by cheque over the summer, or applied against fees for another student if you provide a written request to do so.

<u>Last Day of Regular Classes</u>: Please remember that the last day of regular classes for all students in the Regular and ARP Pathways is June 10th. Prom Ticket Sales are also **OPEN NOW.** If Graduates plan on attending the Prom Dance, they will have to purchase their tickets **by Friday, June 6**. Tickets are 25\$ each, CASH ONLY and can be purchased with Danica in O-201.

▲ Upcoming Sports Concentration Credits – Government-Issued Grants:
